This program will operate congruently with the annual USDF membership year of December 1 - November 30, beginning with the 2020 membership year on December 1, 2019. Four award divisions, including open, junior/young rider, adult amateur, and non-professional, will be recognized per region. The open division will offer six levels of recognition (Training, First, Second, Third, Fourth, and FEI), with the junior/young rider, adult amateur, and non-professional offering an additional seventh level (Introductory).

- 11. Entries received without payment will be charged a \$15 incomplete entry fee. This includes phone, fax and email entries. Accepting a late entry, the responsible party will be liable to pay all class, office, stable and other fees. Withdrawing will not excuse payment of fees.
- 12. All refunds will incur a \$10 processing fee and released after payment is recovered.
- 13. Refunds after closing date will be made only if entry is filled from wait list.
- 14. If show moves to rain date, there will be no refunds, unless rain date is rained out (less \$10 process fee)
