You are invited to ride in the Junior/Young Rider clinic with Alejandro Salazar hosted by the Foothills CDS Chapter. We will be spending two days together with eight lessons each day. The riding schedule will be sent to the participants by October 31, 2019.

Alejandro Salazar specializes in the training and instruction of hunter, jumper and dressage horses and riders in Sacramento and north-central California. Alejandro's passion for horses and riding began when he was a young boy in his homeland of Costa Rica. Now as a professional trainer and competitor, his enthusiasm, expertise and dedication to the sport he loves is demonstrated in all aspects of his programs -- from elevating the abilities and performance of seasoned competitors to starting the young horse under saddle. Clinic Cost: \$75 for 2 lessons (Two 45-minute sessions)

Ride Location: All lessons will be held in the indoor arena. Indoor arena is 80x220 are sand/rubber. Covered 60' Lunge arena.

Preparation and Attire: Please be warmed up, tacked up and ready to ride – for each of your lessons. Be neat and tidy about yourself. Your horse should be well groomed. Conservative dress and classic dressage turnout for you and your horse should be the order of the day (braiding is optional). ASTM/SEI certified safety helmet is required to be worn any time horse is ridden.

Stabling: \$40/night per horse. Stabling is on grounds. Stabling will be in either permanent or temporary stalls. Daily stall cleaning is responsibility of the clinic participant. Bedding is additional at \$8.50 per bale. Pre-order necessary for baled bedding. Please provide your own water bucket, feed and hay for your horse.

Trailer in Fee: \$20 per day for those not stabling.

Clinic Stabling opens on: Friday, November 1 after 1 p.m.

Payment: To guarantee your position in clinic FULL Payment for Clinic must be received by October 31, 2019. Payment can be made by cash or check. Do Not mail cash.

Refunds: Refund is conditional on ability to find replacement entrant.

Food/Snacks: Coffee, tea and cocoa will be available in the office. Snacks and a light lunch will be provided.

Driving Directions: From the South: Hwy 99 N. to Dillard Road Exit (right). From Dillard Road turn left onto Wilton Road, proceeding to 10992 on the left.

From the West: Hwy 80 to 99 south (towards Fresno) exit Grantline. Turn right onto Wilton Road. Proceed to 10992 on the

From the North: I- 5 to Hwy 99 South, exit onto Grantline East. Turn right onto Wilton Road. 1.8 miles on the right. From the East: Hwy 50 from the Tahoe area, exiting to the left on Sunrise Blvd (Rancho Cordova area), right on Grantline Road. Left on Wilton Road. Proceed to 10992 on the right. It is also possible to come from the Reno area on Interstate 80, exiting on Sierra College Blvd. (which becomes Hazel). Then go West on Highway 50, South on Sunrise Blvd, right on Grantline Road. Left on Wilton Road. Proceed to 10992 on the right.
